Report on Business

The Issuer has operations in 4 states:

Florida:

In the State of Florida, the Issuer is a vertically integrated "seed to sale" company and is the first and largest fully licensed medical marijuana company. The Issuer cultivates and produces all of its products in-house and distributes those products to Trulieve branded stores (dispensaries) throughout the State of Florida, as well as directly to patients via home delivery. The Issuer operates approximately 1,684,408 square feet of total cultivation facilities

as well as experimental greenhouse facilities. Potencies range from 15.23% to 32.78% THCA on THC producing varieties and 9.51% to 17.35% CBDA on CBD producing varieties. The Issuer operates a GMP certified processing facility. The Issuer produces 267 different SKUs, including smokable flower, flower pods for vaporizing, concentrates, topicals, capsules, tinctures, and vape cartridges.

The Issuer has 226,560 customers as of October 31, 2019, who average approximately 2 visits per month, and distributes its products to these customers in Trulieve branded retail stores or home delivery. The Issuer operated 38 stores throughout the State of Florida as of October 31, 2019, encompassing over 102,889 square feet of retail space. The Issuer operates a 99-vehicle delivery-service fleet. On August 30, 2019 Trulieve set its new one-day record, serving approximately 9,281 patients across 31 open locations.

California:

The Issuer operates one store in California where it has 99% membership interest.

Massachusetts:

The Issuer has provisional licenses for a cultivation facility, 3 medical and 3 adult dispensaries in the State of Massachusetts.

Connecticut:

The Issuer operates one medical marijuana dispensary in Connecticut.

Call Center:

Patients are further served by a Clearwater-based call center which received on average 4,239 calls per day.

The Issuer serves over 5,773 patients daily.

The Issuer engages with its consumer base via multiple social media platforms. As of October 31, 2019, the Issuer had 82,195 followers on Facebook, 38,721 followers on Instagram, 8,175 followers on Twitter and 1,850 followers on YouTube. 152,711 of the Issuer's customers had opted-in to receive emails, and 49,399 of the Issuer's customers had opted-in to receive texts.

The Issuer was actively looking at various acquisition opportunities in other states and expansion plans for the business in the State of Florida. During the month, the Issuer was

preparing for new dispensary openings in the State of Florida and was working on integration plans for its acquisitions in California, Massachusetts and Connecticut. Management also spent time working on strategic planning, financing activities, integration plans and tactical execution plan for this year. Such plans include, among other things, a focus on inventory and shipment logistics for new dispensary openings, product quality and expansion of new product lines and effective branding and sales and marketing support.
